

“PHOTO-SHOOTING SESSION FEE” RULES IN THE PALAS PUBLIC GARDEN

Private events professional photo – video sessions (wedding, christening, etc.), products or fashion photo shoots shall be allowed within the Palas public garden, irrespective of the season or day of the week, between 10:00 A.M. – 10:00 P.M., only subject to the payment of a photo – shooting fee.

Time interval: **1 hour, only in the Palas public garden.**

Fee: **200 RON** (payable in advance, at the time of the booking).

The fee for the renting of the Venetian Carousel – this is an additional or an independent fee, apart from the photo – shooting sessions within the Palas public garden.

Duration: **approximately 5 minutes**, the carousel being completely vacant (**1 ride**).

Fee: **100 RON.**

Booking and cashing in of the fee / fees shall be done in advance, at the two Information Centers within Palas Mall (Information Center 1 –the Palace of Culture entrance and Information Center 2 – Auchan entrance).

Reservations may also be made on the same day of the photo session and/or shooting. The persons booking the session shall pick up when making the payment, from the Information Centers, **the badges (cards)** that shall indicate **the date and the time interval previously booked**. The badges are no longer valid when the indicated time interval of the booking expires.

Special terms for the persons who made a booking:

- ✓ The persons who were not present within the indicated time interval shall lose their reservation and, by default, the paid amount(s).
- ✓ It is possible that other photo shoots are booked within the same time interval in the public garden, but the generous space allows simultaneous photo – shooting sessions.
- ✓ Some other events organized by Palas Mall may take place in the public garden.

Observations

Taking photos is allowed in the Palas public garden for all persons owning mobile phones or personal photographic cameras, irrespective of their sizes, if the purpose of the photography is strictly a tourism or recreational purpose.
